This will allow our congregations to share ministries as well as sharing a large portion of the operating expenses at Hope. The end result will be a savings of over \$3000 per month for Hope, and \$40,000 for the calendar year.

My hope is that with a year of partnership, our congregation will be able to move towards a balanced budget. If we couple this savings with an aggressive move to pay off our mortgage we will position our congregation to do incredible things in the name of God for our community! We are moving toward financial freedom in order to increase our outreach ministries. As a result, your congregation will be able to become the kind of church that God imagines in scripture. We will be unencumbered by debt so that we can do even more to help those in need in our community, and that is worth the efforts we will share during the months

Yes, we will share my time with LCR, and as a result we are moving our Wednesday night problem. Thursday. programs No to Yes, I will spend fewer hours behind a desk waiting for phone calls, and will not be present at the problem. congregation every day. No Yes, I will be gone one Sunday a month in order to preach at LCR. No problem.

Yes, we will demolish the remainder of our debt so that we can be free to serve. No doubt. Yes, we will enter a new phase in the life of our congregation that will be a cause for celebration and thanksgiving to God. No doubt. Yes, God is faithful in all God's promises, and as long as we keep our eyes on the ministry Christ gave this church we will be everything that God has called us to be. No doubt.

All this is possible because of the flexibility, commitment, and generosity of the members of Hope. I want each of you to know that I will carry this burden along side you, as I also hope to share in the ministry of our congregation to the community as we move towards our promised future. Your time is valued, your commitments are inspiring, and your contributions will be put to good use.

On Sunday August 25, Pastor Nate had a conversation with the congregation that our budget was not going to cover his salary. The Church Council and Fundraising committee conducted a special meeting to discuss a strategy to continue our fundraising for the mortgage. It was voted on that we would place calls to each member to discuss our situation and have members make additional giving above and beyond their current amounts. All new funds will be earmarked for the monthly mortgage payments and not the principal. We have four years left to pay on the mortgage with a balance of \$87,000. With this extra cushion of cash coming in, we will be able to meet our payroll and overhead.

We deeply appreciate any extra giving you can give as we do not want to lose our Pastor. We have a strong and committed congregation who always rises to the occasion and we Thank You for that!
